



Bromham Mill is 1 mile from Bedford at the west end of Bromham Bridge, signposted from the A428 Bedford to Northampton road.

Follow the brown waterwheel signs. The Mill is situated alongside the River Bridge.

Bromham Mill, Bridge End, Bromham, Bedford, MK43 8LP

Bromham Mill is a 17th century working water mill on the river Great Ouse. The Mill is set in seven acres of water meadows, rich in bird and plant life. The river and Mill provide an ideal setting for a picnic. The enormous 26 arch of Bromham Bridge spans the river alongside the Mill.

On Sunday 6 June, the Mill and Gallery Exhibitions will be open and, water levels permitting, the mill will be turning. There is also a gift shop and café.
